

HOUSE RULES OF THE GETTYSBURG FIRE DEPARTMENT

House rule #1 The building must be secured at all times.

House rule #2 The use of tobacco products will be permitted outside of the facility only.

House Rule #3 Food and drinks will not be permitted in the bunkrooms, library, exercise/recreation rooms, museum, radio room and television/AV room. Water permitted in the exercise room.

House rule #4 The consumption of alcoholic beverages will be limited to Departmental activities, excluding emergency responses, and will be restricted to those members of age as defined by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board.

House rule #5 No bikes, skate boards, roller skates, or in-line skates will be permitted anywhere within the facility.

House rule #6 Bunkroom and shower facilities are provided for both male and female members. At no time will any male members enter any female bunk or shower facility nor will any female member enter any male bunk room or shower facility. No member will be permitted to bunk in for longer than three (3) consecutive days without permission from the Chief or President. Blankets, sheets, and pillow cases will be provided by the Department. It is the responsibility of the member bunking in to change the bunk upon completion of their stay and to keep their bunk made up daily. It will be the responsibility of any members to provide their own bath items. The shower facilities will be maintained in a clean and orderly manner at all times. All personal toiletries will be stored in the member's assigned locker or closet provided in the bunkroom.

House rule #7 No pets will be permitted in the facility. EXCEPTION: this section will not prohibit any person who requires the use of a service animal from entering upon the property to attend any function.

House rule #8 Recreation/exercise room and the day room have been provided for the convenience of the members. It will be the responsibility of each member using these facilities to see that they are maintained in a neat and orderly manner AT ALL TIMES. Cooking utensils will be cleaned and put away after each use, trash cans emptied, and floors kept clean.

House rule #9 Horseplay will not be tolerated at any time.

House rule #10 It will be the responsibility of every member of the Department to help maintain the facility in a neat and orderly manner AT ALL TIMES. All equipment will be stored in a proper manner and in its proper place.

House rule #11 A member violating or contributing to a violation of a house rule will be subject to disciplinary action.

House rule #12 Proposed changes to the house rules must be submitted in writing to the Board of Officers.
